The financial agreement between EHL and the HES-SO states that the HES-SO will cover part of the tuition fees of eligible students. According to this agreement, academic tuition invoiced to these students is limited to CHF 1'000 per academic year, the remainder being paid by the HES-SO. It does not apply to the Preparatory Year, which is not covered by this agreement.

Eligibility for a subsidy:

Aside from Swiss students whose parents live in Switzerland, other students may be eligible for an A-HES subsidy should they meet one of the below conditions at time of immatriculation:

- Students with Swiss nationality who live abroad or whose parents live abroad
- Refugees and stateless persons of age assigned to a canton in Switzerland
- Foreign students of age whose civil residence is located in Switzerland (excluding B permit for education purposes)
- Foreign students who have lived permanently for at least two years in the same canton in Switzerland, where they have had a full-time paid employment giving them financial independence without undertaking a training course at the same time
- Foreign students whose parents' or legal guardians' civil residence is located in Switzerland
- Foreign students whose parents live abroad and who have at least one parent working in the canton of Geneva and holding a G permit

The questionnaire determining the granting of an A-HES subsidy will be sent to students one month before the start of the academic year. Only the HES-SO has the authority to determine a student's status. Should a student abandon his or her studies or change A-HES status for any other reason before 15 October or 15 April, depending on the half-year in progress, the HES-SO will stop contributing to tuition fees.

Details

ACADEMIC TUITION INCLUDES

Academic courses, exam fees, guest lectures, preparatory year including field trips and workshops in different locations, support for internships and access to industry partners for student business projects and these as well as language courses.

INFRASTRUCTURES & SERVICES INCLUDE

- Access to all sports facilities and sports activity training
- Student Affairs Services: coaching, psychological support, sport and health center
- Internships and Career Services: Internship planning & monitoring, job fairs on campus
- Access to Digital Centre and professional print-shop services
- Mandatory Swiss insurances: accident, public liability, theft, computer equipment insurance covering theft and damage
- Extracurricular student activities
- Kitchen and service uniforms
- Equipment for practical and theory classes (wines, utensils, etc.)
- Lifelong Alumni membership

PREPAID FOOD & BEVERAGE CREDIT

At the beginning of each academic year, student cards are charged with a mandatory minimum amount to cover meals and beverages taken in the outlets on campus. The prepaid amount must be used before the end of the academic year and is non-refundable. Any remaining amount at the end of the academic year is transferred to EHL's scholarship fund. Students can recharge their card at any time. The recharged amount can be refunded at the end of their studies if not used.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Basic health and accident insurance is mandatory by law in Switzerland. Students whose fiscal residence – or whose parents' fiscal residence – is outside Switzerland are automatically enrolled in EHL's health and accident insurance plan. An exemption may be obtained by providing proof of adequate coverage to the Swiss authorities. (e.g: European health insurance card). The annual premium of CHF 1'620 is subject to change.

SWISS RESIDENCE TAX & VISA EXPENSES

Administrative taxes are collected by the Swiss authorities for residence permits and visas. Other communal and cantonal fees may apply. A tourist tax of CHF 18.50 per 15 days will be invoiced to students whose legal address is not in Switzerland (legal obligation) for the duration of their stay on campus.

ON-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION & PARKING

- Preparatory Year: Students are encouraged to live on campus during the first semester. The price per person in a double room is CHF 5'850 (a deposit of CHF 1'950 will be required and returned at the end of the contract if there has been no damage). Individual rooms are also available. The price per person per semester is CHF 7'800 (with a deposit of CHF 2'362). Heating, electricity, internet, cleaning and laundry services are included in the price.
- Following years: Students will have the choice between accommodations on campus (double or individual rooms) or in NeighborWood (single or shared apartments). The price per person per semester ranges from CHF 7'087 to CHF 4'237 (a deposit of CHF 2'362 and CHF 1'412 respectively will be required). Heating, electricity and internet are included in the price. Students are fully responsible for the daily and final cleaning of the apartment. Laundry is not included.
- For comparison purposes, a simple studio in the Lausanne region leases in general for 12 months at approximately CHF 1'400 per month, excluding heating, electricity, wifi etc.
- Interior and exterior parking spaces are available on campus for a fee per semester respectively of CHF 1'500 and CHF 720.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

- Other expenses such as textbooks and application fees are not included. Plan on an approximate budget of CHF 150 per semester for study materials. A fee of CHF 175 is due upon the submission of an application. If students need to retake examinations, the fee is CHF 300 per retake.
- All students are required to register at HES-SO (CHF 150).
- EHL Campus Lausanne is expanding. Parking and lodging will be confirmed as and when the new student residences become available. Prices are subject to change.

Terms & Conditions of Payment

DOWN PAYMENT

After confirmation of admission to EHL, students are required to pay a down payment on tuition fees of CHF 6'000 within 15 days in order to guarantee their place. This amount is non-refundable, except in extreme circumstances. This down payment amount is then deducted from the total amount due.

Important note: In addition to the down payment of CHF 6'000, Swiss authorities require students from outside the EU/EFTA to make an initial payment of CHF 18'000 before submitting a visa application. This amount will be deducted from their first invoice.

INVOICING

The total amount of the compulsory fees is invoiced before the beginning of each academic year and payment is due within 30 days of reception. Students are charged the totality of compulsory fees as a lump sum (in accordance with Art. 160 & ff, Code des Obligations) even if they do not take up their place at the start of term or complete the academic year. Should a student suspend or repeat an academic year, the latest official fees apply.

DEPOSIT (REIMBURSED AT THE END OF STUDIES)

A deposit of CHF 5'000 is required from all new students. This deposit covers any exceptional costs which may arise, for example from damage to rooms or materials. The deposit will be reimbursed at the end of the student's studies at EHL. Interest earned on the deposit will accrue and be added to EHL's scholarship Foundation, as part of the institution's social responsibility policy for the education of students with financial difficulties. Students who abandon their studies during the academic year must inform EHL of their decision one month before the beginning of the next academic session in order to be eligible to request a refund of the deposit.

These prices are defined based on the inflation rate forecasted by the Swiss National Bank (BNS). Should there be a strong variation, EHL will make adjustments accordingly. For further information please consult our website: www.ehl.edu
